Jesus didn't come to satisfy our selfish desires, egos or appetites! He came to be to the soul, what bread is to the body.



Our first completed project

It is with great thanks to God we are able to report on a very exciting year. We have been doing research to find people who are unreached, but also isolated from the gospel. In one place we have come across a large people group with millions of people unable to access the Gospel. Due to the conditions that these people live in, we are unable to disclose their country or the specifics of the work we are doing. However, we still want to share with you a glimpse of this project.

As part of our research we looked into different mission organisations that are in the process of reaching this particular people group and their different methods of doing so. Unfortunately, many of these methods are either very risky, or not very effective for the people. In this process, God opened up the door for us to work with *Voice of the Martyrs* (VOM). Our aim is always to provide technical assistance to partner organisations (such as VOM), working with them because their expertise, in their particular field of ministry is something we lack. VOM indicated that they do have needs, and that they could use our assistance to make their work more effective. They have provided us with materials for tests and helped us understand their specific needs.

With the goals given to us by VOM our team got to work. The outcome is that New Testaments can now be

taken to places where this was not previously possible. We may never be able to report on results such as how the New Testaments have impacted the lives of these people, however, what we do know, is that these people are aware that they are given a bible as these people are literate and the New Testament given to them is written in their heart language. Their cultural background also allows them to understand the way of salvation based on reading the bible only.

What inspires us to continue to help VOM into the future with their ministry is the fact that these isolated people from the underground church want to receive more New Testaments. They have stated that these deliveries are the most effective way of reaching their people group with the gospel.

As we start this New Year, will you pray with us? Pray that these people receiving a New Testament will have hearts prepared through the Holy Spirit to understand and embrace the liberating Truth of the Gospel. Many in this people group are held captive politically, some physically as well. Yet we know that some of these people are truly free in Jesus, and we praise God for this! Through their testimonies we are reminded that the freedom experienced in Christ surpasses all liberation that this world could ever offer.

Providing air transport to reach the Himalayan people

In 2015 Lord willing, we would like to expand our work to a country of 30 million people in the Himalayas. We are working on finalising the practical arrangements for this to go ahead in partnership with a well-known bible translation organisation.

Many parts of this country are geographically isolated. Difficult terrain, infrastructure destroyed or damaged by conflict, rapid deforestation, environmental damage, and susceptibility to natural disasters all weigh heavily against development. Recovery will be difficult so long as current political instability remains. Despite significant hindrances, Himalayan country, which was effectively an isolated medieval kingdom, has made notable progress in the last 50 years.

About 300 ethnic sub-groups and castes speak more than 120 languages with 49% being literate. Some of these sub-groups remain isolated and have not had the opportunity to hear the gospel.

In 1952 the first church was formed with 29 believers, and by 2010 there were 850,000 followers of Christ, most of who came from lower castes. This evangelic growth was achieved by the willingness of

these people to suffer for the gospel, profound prayerfulness, and a local-driven long-term commitment to evangelism and church planting. Converts from Hinduism to Christ usually become outcasts, even more challenging for converts in the face of increasing fundamental Hinduism.

Our plan is to work in partnership with missions and ministries that are already established in this region. We aim to help them by providing air transport to reach these people groups and castes that are still unreached. Like any project, a lot of preparation has already taken place to work in this area. We hope to make a final decision with the board early this year regarding our commitment to support this project.

- Please pray with us for perseverance for believers, that neither laws of man nor threats of violence will deter them from sharing the gospel.
- Pray also for the unreached groups/castes, that their hearts will be ready and Christ will soon be revealed to them.
- Lastly, pray for wisdom and guidance for HFA's board as they consider this project and make decisions for the next steps.

- Pray for our daily bread, that the Lord will open the floodgates of heaven and provide the needed resources.


Sharing about the inaccessible and unreached in churches
